CEDO: Reduction of Medical Errors-HS

Optical Seminars: The Prevention of Medical and Ophthalmic Errors

Pursuant to section 456.013(7), Florida Statutes, the 2-hour course relating to prevention of medical errors shall be approved by the Board. Following discussion, the Board took the following action:

POF: Reduction of Medical Errors

RULE DISCUSSION

64B12-9.0015 Application for Examination and Licensure

House Bill 941 removed the requirement for a two hour medical errors course for initial licensure and removed a section in 456.0635, F.S., requiring the removal of a history question. The updated application was reviewed by the Board and following discussion, the following action was taken:

Motion: by Mr. Calvo to accept the language changes in the rule.

Second: by Mr. Williams.

Vote: unanimous.

Motion: by Mr. Girdler that this will have no economic impact on small business and a SERC is not

required.

Second: by Mr. Williams.

Vote: unanimous.

Motion: by Mr. Calvo to approve the changes to the application removing the requirement for a 2 hour

course on medical errors and the one criminal history question.

Second: by Mr. Girdler. Vote: unanimous.

64B12-16.003 Apprenticeship Requirements and Training Program
